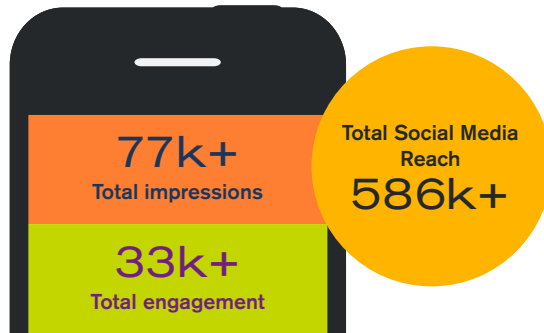

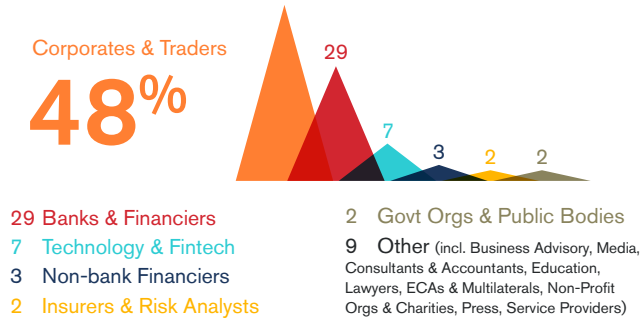

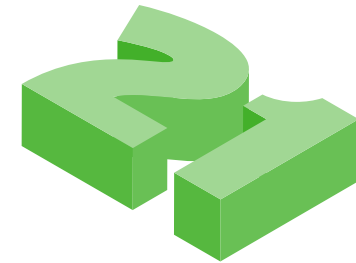
Social media engagement in 2026



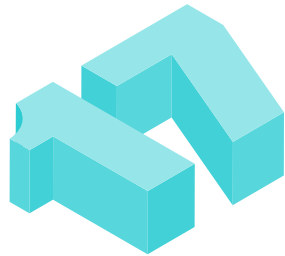
Attendees by sector in 2026

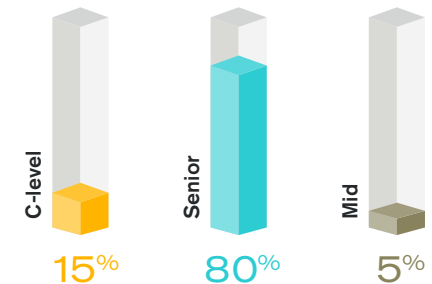
Countries represented in 2026



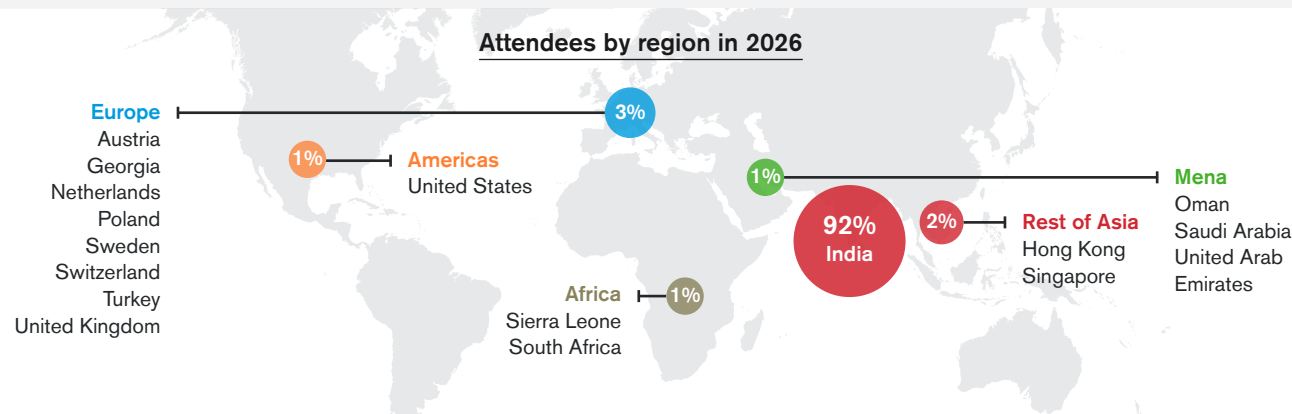
